

Sandra Irby Buchanan, Esq. is Statewide Special Counsel for Ethics for the New York State Office of Court Administration. In that capacity, she is responsible for overseeing the operations of the Judicial Campaign Ethics Center, which provides ethics advice and training to judicial candidates, and the Non-Judicial Ethics Helpline, which provides ethics advice and training to non-judicial court employees. Additionally, Ms. Buchanan serves as staff counsel to the Advisory Committee on Judicial Ethics.

In 2007, Ms. Buchanan began her legal career as a Court Attorney at the New York State Court of Appeals and later became Senior Principal Law Clerk to Associate Judges Theodore T. Jones and Jenny Rivera of the New York State Court of Appeals. She later joined Rivkin Radler LLP as a commercial litigation associate.
